### **Chinatown Business Association (CBA) Extends Rental Discounts of 25% until March 23**

*Attractive rental packages for new and existing Street Market Tenants*

6 September 2022 - Chinatown Business Association (CBA) will continue to offer rental relief packages for its street market standalone stall tenants for another six months. Standalone stall tenants of Chinatown Street Market along Pagoda Street, Trengganu Street, Sago Street and Smith Street can enjoy a rental rate of 25% discount during the period from 9th September 2022 to 8th March 2023. The first rental concessions started in June 2021.

“We are glad that our tenants are seeing returning tourists in the recent weeks. We are seeing the return of tourists in our Chinatown Street Market. Chinatown remains an attractive destination for both locals and visitors, and our team has been actively developing programmes to promote Chinatown as one of Singapore’s iconic tourist destinations for its Eat, Shop, Play activities. To further support our existing standalone stall tenants and to welcome new tenants, we will offer rental relief to our standalone stall tenants for another six months,” said Ms. Lim Yick Suan, Executive Director, Chinatown Business Association.

As part of its strategy to promote Chinatown as an exciting and vibrant destination for everyone, the marketing team at CBA, with the support of stakeholders, is actively promoting Chinatown’s unique offerings, trendy stores, food editorials and top festival picks through social media channels as well as through livestreaming .

New activities include the Feng Jie Heritage Tour, where participants will be taken on a journey of emotions to learn about Chinatown’s history through theatrical walking tour. Other unique experiences include fortnightly workshops which are conducted outdoors as part of a Singapore street market experience. Some of the more popular workshops include lantern making, pottery and clay making and resin painting, just to name a few.

Special events are also organised during this Mid-Autumn Festival celebration, with Chinese Fan , Chinese Flower Lantern and to Hair Accessories Workshops. Many of the participants don Hanfu costumes to create memorable photos for social media sharing.
